 Choose the appropriate search parameter from the drop down menu under "Search By". Choose from Civic Address, Rural Address, Alberta Township Survey (ATS) System Number, Lot/Block/Plan, Land Identification Numeric Code (LINC), NHBPS Application ID, NHBPS Unit ID, or Builder.

- 6. To learn more information about a property, click on a property in the grid and the property detail page will pop up.
- 7. When done viewing the Property Detail page, scroll down and select close, or click on the X in the top right corner.
- 8. After closing the Property Detail page, if you wish to do another search, click on the reset button to clear information from the previous search.

Search Tips

- 1. The property registry contains information on homes registered since February 1, 2014, the date the *New Home Buyer Protection Act* came into force. The property registry does not contain information on homes built prior to February 1, 2014.
- 2. All homes in the property registry are searchable by NHBPS Application ID, NHBPS Unit ID, and Builder.

- 3. The property registry will contain information for at least one of these parameters for each home, but might not contain information for all four: Civic Address Rural Address, Lot/Block/Plan, or Alberta Township Survey (ATS) number. If you cannot find a home by searching for one of these parameters, try searching for another.
- 4. Some homes in the property registry may contain partial information for Civic Address or Rural Address.
- 5. If you cannot find a home by searching for a complete Civic Address, try the following:
 - a. Do not include Postal Code in your search.
 - b. Do not include Unit/Suite/Apt. Number in your search.
 - c. Search by Municipality and Street Number; if your search is not successful, add Street Name and Street Type.
- 6. If you cannot find a home by searching for a complete Rural Address, try the following:
 - a. Do not include Postal Code in your search.
 - b. Do not include Unit/Suite/Apt. number in your search.
 - c. Search by Municipality; if your search is not successful, add Street Name or Range Road.
